Dear Parents and Carers,

Yesterday, we took the whole school down to the Shebbear war memorial. We were joined by Reverend Warren in paying our respects to those who sacrificed so much for us, all those years ago.

Some of the children read poems as well as a prayer and the laying of a wreath. As one of the children was reading, a horse trotted by so I used the opportunity to remind the children that our equine friends also showed great bravery, with many heading off to the battlefields in 1914.

I came across some details of those killed in WW1. For example, Austin Clarke was the son of the local Shebbear doctor while Arthur Stacey and Embert Adams were both particularly unfortunate, losing their lives just a couple of weeks before the armistice in November 1918. The children were immaculately behaved not least during a period of silence and given the very cold and wet weather we endured during our visit. They were a real credit to the school.
