Dear Parents and Carers,

Mrs Hawker and myself have spent lots of time over the last week or so planning the school budget for the next year. Each year the school is allocated a sum of money in order to operate the school for the year ahead. This is predominantly based on how many children we have in the school. From here we need to calculate the costs for the year ahead. The largest chunk of this is for staff salaries so we also have to plan our staffing structure for the next year.

As you can imagine, it can be quite a challenge balancing what you want, what you need and what you can afford! If we have got our sums correct, I think we have found a good way forward and will have, ready for September, an effective staffing structure.

School budgets remain high on the list of headteacher concerns across both the county and the country. One of the biggest factors has been the decline in birth rates in recent years – it turns out the lockdown of 2020 didn't result in the expected baby boom (possibly spending all that time together at home had the opposite effect). Fortunately, we seem to be bucking the trend at the moment and our numbers remain buoyant. I work closely with Mrs Elston at Little Bears so we normally have a good idea of who to expect in the future.

Once the budget has been approved by our governors, I should be able to share with you our staffing plans for September.
