Dear Parents and Carers,

The newsletter is a day early this week because **we are closed tomorrow for a non-pupil day and again on Monday for an occasional day.**Hopefully you will be able to use at least some of the long weekend as family time or to even get away for a day or two.

Staff are using the non-pupil day to write end of year reports which will be coming to you just before the end of term in July. As you can imagine, they are quite a time consuming job but a great opportunity to reflect of what the children have learnt over the year and the progress they have made.

With the report will be confirmation of which class and teacher the children will have in September. While there are a couple of points to iron out, I can confirm that the class structure should remain the same as we are now so, as an example, if your child is in Year 2 they should be moving up to Panda class in September.

I was asked recently by a parent whether we were considering joining a Multi Academy Trust at any point. The simple answer to this is no. We have previously been approached – ironically by MATs who are both suffering real difficulties at this time. We do work collaboratively with a number of other local schools but this is very much in an informal way with a focus on inter school support and opportunities. For example, Mrs Fuller attended a session this week with other reception teachers to look at comparative attainment to ensure our judgements are accurate. Similarly, our residential trip to London in a couple of weeks is being run in conjunction with two other schools within our schools' group meaning we have been able to share costs and thereby keep the price lower.

We will continue to work with these schools next year but, for me, I much prefer this informal arrangement rather than being tied in both financially and in terms of how the school has to be run, which would be an inevitable outcome of joining a MAT.
