Other news this week

Attendance: We have seen quite a bit of illness this week and this has impacted on the overall attendance figures. It is also a good reminder to avoid any unnecessary absences because you can never be sure when an unavoidable one may come along such as a sickness bug. Panda led the way with an impressive 98% attendance followed by Teddy on 90.94% and Koala on 90%.

<u>Illness:</u> As mentioned above, we have had a fair bit of illness over the last couple of weeks with a couple of bugs doing the rounds. It has raised the question of the ongoing 48 hour rule – meaning you are not allowed to bring your child back to school until they have been clear for 48 hours. While we are not abandoning this completely, parents/carers are welcome to contact the school to seek further advice after the initial 48 hours. While we would not want to encourage children back into school while they are still unwell, we also don't want children being off for any longer than is necessary.

As such, a case by case approach may be a better compromise. In the same vain, do contact us if you are ever unsure about whether your child is well enough to come in. We are always happy to advise.
