Dear Parents and Carers,

I could not have envisaged on Wednesday morning that I would be sending a message out in the evening, saying that the school was closing the following day.

Thank you for your understanding about this. Clearly the impact of Storm Ciaran was not as great as had been anticipated. The challenge we always have in these situations (and luckily they don't come around too often) is balancing giving everyone sufficient notice while waiting as long as possible to see how the weather actually turns out.

Devon County Council contacted all schools on Wednesday afternoon highlighting the weather warning and suggesting that school closure may have to be an option. The reasoning is always around the safety of pupils and staff both in terms of physically getting into and home from school as well as safety around the school site.

As other schools announce their closure, it starts to put pressure on you to do the same. We were certainly far from alone with, at the last check, 291 schools across the county closing (out of about 320 in total).

Hopefully the children were able to access their home learning and they had plenty to get on with during the day.

I am sure that all of us hope that we won't have to deal with these kind of issues again in the near future.
