<u>Cricket:</u> I'm sure other cricket nerds out there will know that a week from today, the Ashes series starts when England take on Australia in a five match series. I'm pleased to say that we also have lots of cricket going on ourselves. We played (and won) our first match in a new after school league – report from Mrs Evans below – with our next game coming up this Monday. Then on Wednesday, we are taking a team over to North Devon Cricket Club at Instow to take part in a tournament. Meanwhile, a number of Shebbear children are taking part in the All Stars and Dynamos programmes run at the weekend as well as starring for the Hatherleigh youth teams. It is great to see so many children getting involved!

It was a pleasure to accompany the team to Westcroft School on Monday for the first cricket league fixture. It was a closely fought game with some excellent bowling, fielding and batting from both teams. Well done to all of our players who conducting themselves and participated brilliantly. The end result went our way with the final score of 136 runs to us and 132 to Westcroft.

Year 1 phonics and Y4 Multiplication Tables: The final couple of statutory assessments started this week with Year 4 pupils undertaking the multiplication tables test. This is done online in a format that is very similar to TT Rock Stars. The children complete 25 random times tables questions in a very strict time limit. Next week, these will be completed and the Year 1 children will undertake their phonics screening assessment. Here the children have to identify 40 words using their phonics knowledge. This is completed on a one to one basis and will be overseen by Mrs Wood next Thursday and Friday morning.
